BTech Program in Computer Science and Design

- Duration -- 4 year programme

BTech program in IT and Social Science

Social Sciences and Humanities were earlier considered studies primarily about humans and societies and their programs were generally far removed from technology and sciences. Today, Information Technology and Computing is playing an important role in many social science subjects, and in some cases, like Social Media, technology and social science aspects have merged. On many problems, Social Sciences are using computing techniques to further understanding of Social Sciences and Humanities. This unique program, BTech in IT and SS, aims to develop IT engineers with strong understanding of relevant social science disciplines. The program will also allow a student to pursue further studies in social sciences, besides allowing students to pursue higher studies in CS/IT as well as many interdisciplinary programs.

- Duration 4 year programme
- Eligibility/Selection procedure -- admission to the program may be based on class XII performance, as is done in DU and AUD. There is a possibility of taking half form JEE and half based on class XII marks. *Though it might change*
